## Application Instructions

- Submit the two letters of recommendation found in this packet from current or past teachers. Provide each teacher with the form as well as a plain white envelope with your name on it. Each teacher is to place their signature across the seal of the envelope. Unsealed or tampered envelopes with result in disqualification.
- Submit the required self-evaluation in your own words, typed or handwritten. Spelling, grammar and neatness count.
